Holidays . . . Time for God?

This summer ICS is sharing the good news of Jesus Christ with tourists, holiday reps, Scouts and Guides who, whilst away, are often more open to think about faith. Our volunteer seasonal chaplains need your prayers as they minister in resorts across Europe (see page iv). Chaplains also offer pastoral support to those in need and invite people to church services—several thousand attend annually. This evangelistic and pre-evangelistic incarnational ministry is a major part of ICS's English-language mission.

Would you become a Friend of the seasonal outreach?

Providing a week's seasonal chaplaincy costs at least £500, depending on resort, so your one-off or regular gift(s) will enable ministry in a resort and make an enormous difference to people's lives. Just complete and return this form or give on line selecting 'Seasonal outreach' as the ministry you wish to support. Thank you.



A week's **outreach** to tourists in France, Italy, Switzerland or Spain costs ICS between £500 and £800 (depending on resort), enabling a volunteer chaplain and spouse to be resident to publicise and hold services. Just £6/month would enable ministry for one day or £12 for two days.

A further £50,000 is needed to improve lighting and heating at St. Peter's, Zermatt and carry out other essential repairs to make it an even more welcoming place for worshippers and the many tourists who visit this historic memorial chapel.
