



## ICS: supporting international Anglican churches

ICS, as a voluntary society of the Church of England, is quite distinct from a diocese and partners international Anglican churches in two specialist ways: first, as a private patron, recruiting (in partnership with bishops and their congregations) and nominating ministers to serve international Anglican churches/chaplaincies; we also hold in trust numerous church buildings and chaplaincy houses for the long-term benefit of English-language ministry. Secondly, we support the mission of dioceses and their congregations through church growth and church planting projects.

We have planted numerous churches since 1823 and support chaplaincy ministry through the prayers of our supporters and prayer groups, our prayerful interest as an experienced Anglican patron, twinning with parishes in the UK, advice and practical help on church growth and ministry initiatives, conferences and consultations on mission and discipleship, help with lay appointments such as student workers or interns, recommending locum priests, and with our experience of ministry to tourists. Chaplaincies (given high congregational turnover) can be fragile entities so, subject to resources, we can offer other financial assistance to enable ministry, for example, loans for church building projects where we are trustees.

## INFORMATION FOR DONORS

**UK taxpayers:** the value of your gift(s) to a charity can be increased at no extra cost to you by using Gift Aid. You can use Gift Aid if (during a tax year) you pay an amount of UK income or capital gains tax at least equal to the amount of tax we will reclaim on your gift. Please complete the declaration if you are eligible. If your tax position (such that you can no longer use the Gift Aid scheme), name or address changes please notify the charity immediately. We may periodically ask you to reconfirm your tax status.

## English is the lingua franca of our times

People from all over the world speak English, including some 38 per cent of continental Europeans. At ICS's heart is communicating God's good news, Jesus Christ, to them all. Will you help us with these three outreach initiatives that will touch the lives of many who are working, studying or relaxing far from home?

Three successive ICS-funded interns at Holy Trinity Brussels (cost £28,000 over three years) working amongst the many young people working or studying at the heart of the EU. The interns also enable the workplace ministry of Dr Gary Wilton, the Church of England Representative to the EU Institutions and an ICS mission partner.

A warm Christian welcome to international students, who are far from their families, through the work of ICS-supported international student workers at international Anglican churches in European university cities (cost £2,666 each).

Evangelism amongst tourists in some fourteen European resorts this summer, where ICS volunteer chaplains are holding church services and relating to many who never attend church and know little of Christianity—see July 2010's *ICS News*, page 8.
