Spouses are warmly invited to come to the interviews and to participate in the process as much as they wish. Our reasons for wanting to include them are that it gives opportunity for them to become more aware

- that the moving of home to a foreign country is a major event with far reaching consequences for all concerned
- that the role of a spouse within the chaplaincy itself varies enormously both with the person and the chaplaincy
- of information so as to be better able to discuss the response to any offer of appointment and
- of a sense of rightness or otherwise of being involved in such a move.
